

# Arena Rules

- Keep gate closed at all times.
- No sitting on or tying horses to arena fence.
- All Spectators must remain outside the arena and clear from the gate.
- Clean manure when finished. Remove equipment and store in designated area.
- When riding head on. Pass left shoulder to left shoulder.
- Slower gaits to the middle, faster gaits to the outside.
- Mount out of the way. (Usually in the middle)
- Cue quietly, maintain a respectful noise level and do not crowd other riders.
- Always discuss special activities with others. If activities are conflicting, limit each to 30 minute intervals. (First come first serve)
- When others are waiting, limit turn out to 15 minutes.
- Lunging limited to a maximum of two well controlled horses.
- No mounted riders while others are lunging. (In the event of conflict those lunging should move to the round pen.)
- No loose horses while riders are mounted.
- No "out of control" horses. If another rider feels uncomfortable, or your horse is unsettling another, please yield to their concerns and notify staff.
- All riders must stop and dismount during an emergency. (Loose horse, fallen rider etc.)
- In the event of an injured rider or horse. Anyone not helping must quietly and calmly leave the arena.
- If the Arena should become flooded please stay completely clear of wet or spongy areas. (If this rule is not respected we will be forced to close the arena when wet.)
